

Privacy Policy

Ingram Capital is committed to protecting the personal information you provide when using our website. Our Privacy Policy outlines how we handle and safeguard the personal data we collect from individuals who access our website or services.

USE OF INFORMATION

Ingram Capital uses any data you provide in accordance with this Privacy Policy. For example, if you contact us by email, we will use that data to address your inquiry or resolve your issue. Similarly, if you provide data to access our services, we will use it to grant you access and monitor your usage. Additionally, we may obtain information from third-party sources to verify your identity, enabling us to properly process your requests and prevent fraud.

Ingram Capital will use your data for several purposes: (1) to market our products and services to you, (2) to provide the services and products you request, (3) to enable our vendors and contractors to assist with the marketing, operation, troubleshooting, and analysis of our website and other services, (4) to comply with any legal or regulatory requirements for offering or selling securities to our affiliates or members, (5) to engage in other lawful activities consistent with the above, and (6) to protect against legal liability. We may outsource any of these services to third parties, which may require sharing your data with them.

Ingram Capital and its affiliates (the "Affiliated Companies") may use the data collected through the Site to improve the content and functionality of the Site, better understand our users, and enhance our services. We may also use this information to communicate with you about our services or tell you about offerings we think may interest you. OUR DISCLOSURE OF YOUR DATA AND OTHER INFORMATION

USE OF COOKIES

Ingram Capital's website employs various technologies, including electronic tags known as "cookies," to collect, store, and analyze data about user activity on the site.
